

## PowerPlus Youth Camp 2010 REGISTRATION INFORMATION

### Camp Cost:

- Early Registration – \$200 per student/sponsor (*postmarked* on or before deadline)
- Late Registration – \$225 per student/sponsor (*postmarked* after deadline)

### Deposit: \$100 per person (\$125 for Late Registrations)

**Reservations: We accept reservations on a first-come, first-served basis beginning January 1, 2010 (50% of Deposit required).**

- Submit ONE completed Reservation Form.
- Submit 50% of Deposit – \$50 per person (students and sponsors)

*You will be notified promptly via email upon receipt of your reservation. Prepare to send in forms and the remainder of your deposit by the Registration Deadline.*

**Registration Deadline: Postmark your group's registration by the deadline to receive the Early Registration camp cost (100% of Deposit required).**

- Submit one completed Church Form.
- Submit COMPLETE REGISTRATIONS for each person (students and sponsors) coming to camp.
  1. Fully completed Registration/Medical Form
  2. 100% of Deposit

*An email confirmation and church summary will be sent to you after we receive and process your group's registration and will include information on sponsor training and materials.*

#### Registration Policy

A complete registration includes the total deposit and the Registration/Medical Form. We do not hold spots for incomplete registrations. Any amount paid above the required deposit for complete registrations will be applied to your balance due. Cancellations made by the Registration Deadline will avoid any forfeit. Cancellations made after the Registration Deadline and up to two weeks prior to the first day of camp will forfeit 50% of the deposit. Registrations canceled during the two weeks prior to or on the first day of camp will forfeit the full deposit. Deposits are transferable to another camper, but not to the balance due.

# PowerPlus Camp Rules

*PLEASE READ AND SIGN AT BOTTOM OF REGISTRATION FORM*

- Pineywoods is a Christian camp, and all rules are to help us in our conduct and to reflect Christ in all that we do.
- Please respect all camp properties just as you would at the church you attend. We ask you to assist in keeping the grounds clean of trash. Cans are provided campwide to contain debris.
- Items not permitted: illegal drugs, alcohol, knives, ANY form of tobacco, guns, pets, skateboards or fireworks. Such items will be confiscated.
- Unless used specifically for camp program, the following are prohibited while at camp: radios, CD or tape players, cell phones, I-pods, and other non-essential electronic devices. These tend to distract from the intended atmosphere.
- If property or equipment is damaged, your group will be held responsible for any cost incurred for repair or replacement.
- If dorm room is excessively filthy during your stay or upon departure, your church will be assessed a fine of \$50.
- The lake is for canoeing, paddleboating, or fishing. The lake is not approved by the Health Department for swimming. A lifeguard must be present, and life jackets worn while a camper is in any boat.
- Shorts are permitted, but must be at least fingertip length.
- Shoes must be worn at all times (unless camper is in the pool or on sand volleyball courts)
- No hats are to be worn during worship.
- No clothing which is revealing, suggestive, or advertises alcohol or tobacco products will be allowed.
- No spaghetti strap garments will be allowed.
- Swimsuits must be modest – for guys, no Speedo-types – for girls, no thong-types or 2-piece bikini-style (midriff must be covered) or a colored t-shirt must be worn while at the pool. Lifeguards have discretion and can eject anyone not properly clothed from pool area.
- Shaving cream fights, water fights, etc. will not be tolerated. A group doing such in or near enough a building to cause damage will face a charge of \$100.
- No use of the Ropes Course will be allowed unless Pineywoods authorized, trained personnel are present.
- Meals must be taken in the Dining Hall unless otherwise prearranged with the camp.
- Students are not allowed to leave the campgrounds while attending Youth Camp unless with “Out Group”.
- Students must attend all scheduled sessions and activities throughout the week.
- Students are not allowed to ride in or on any vehicle during the camp (unless en-route to Mission Project with “OUT” group).
- Students are not allowed to enter the dorms of campers of the opposite sex for ANY reason.
- PDA will not be tolerated. (Public or Private)
- Students are not allowed to share ANY medication belonging to them with any other student – all medication (prescription and non-prescription) must be checked in with the camp medic upon arrival.
- No golf carts, four-wheelers, or ATVs of any kind are allowed on camp except those used by the camp staff.

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*Pineywoods carries an accident policy on registered guests. This policy is intended to supplement your own insurance, and it will pay only to its limits. There is no deductible. Sickness and pre-existing conditions are not covered. This policy will pay only for accidents immediately reported to Pineywoods. This insurance does not cover members of your group who leave the grounds during your stay. Unauthorized activities may not be covered. All claims must be reported on forms provided by Pineywoods.*

## **ATTENTION YOUTH MINISTER / RESPONSIBLE SPONSOR:**

**PowerPlus Camp offers a special opportunity to all 2010 High School Graduates! The special opportunity is called the “OUT GROUP”. The “OUT GROUP” is designed to assist you as a Youth Minister to move these students out of youth ministry onto a college campus or into the work force. Because graduating seniors are so different than other students at camp they follow a different format during the day. The format is designed to challenge students in service, leadership and following God in His mission to the world.**

**The “OUT GROUP” does not participate in Tournament Recreation. During tournament time, the “OUT GROUP” will be on the Low Ropes Challenge Course developing team work, unity and trust. Please take time to discuss this with your graduating seniors and help them make a responsible decision! By informing them and leading them to prepare for this special opportunity, they will have a better understanding of what to expect when they arrive at camp.**

**A major part of the “OUT GROUP” Experience is what happens during service projects. During the last full day of camp the “OUT GROUP” will be putting into practice what they have been learning all week. They will be participating in hands on mission service projects and learning new and valuable skills to strengthen future mission teams. The students will be involved in all aspects of construction from cutting and nailing boards to electrical work to painting. Help your students come prepared to work by bringing proper work clothes and gloves. *Due to the expense of this type of training an additional mission project fee of \$20.00 per person is required for participation in the “OUT GROUP” Program.* This fee will be charged the first day of camp at check-in.**

**Please take notice of the form required for “OUT GROUP” Participation. This registration format will help you clearly communicate to your 2010 Graduating Seniors. An “OUT GROUP” Schedule has been attached so there are no surprises for you or your student. As the youth minister or responsible sponsor you and your student will be signing the Schedule Form stating you have discussed the format and schedule of the “OUT” Program. The "OUT GROUP" program is a specialized program designed to challenge students who graduate high school in 2010. This challenge is to assist students to transition from youth ministry to college campuses or the work force. The program is focused on service, leadership and participating with God on His mission in the world. Those registering for the "OUT GROUP" are choosing to participate with a higher degree of study, interaction and service in their camp experience. Students choosing to participate in the Out Group will not participate in Recreation Tournaments. Out Group Students should come prepared to participate in all aspects of the program with proper attire for ropes course, mission project and service objectives. Appropriate shorts and shirts are required for ropes course along with closed toed shoes. Mission projects will require clothes for all sorts of construction skills from climbing ladders to painting. Each night Out Group Students help in the Worship Service through taking up the Mission Offering. Students should pack clothes that exhibit the high end of camp requirements to help with setting the standard for worship attire. **An additional project fee of \$20.00 is required for each student registering for the "OUT GROUP". This fee will be charged the first day of camp at check-in.**

I also acknowledge that tournament recreation will not be an option, because I will be involved on the Low Ropes Challenge Course with the Out Group Leadership.*
